### Enrolment Application Fee

The fee to lodge an application for enrolment is \$100 per student. This is payable at the time of application.

### Acceptance Fee Deposit

Upon advice from the school that the enrolment application is successful, a non refundable fee deposit of \$250 is payable. This fee deposit will be deducted from your Annual Tuition Fee in the year you commence with John Paul College.

### The following options are available at additional cost:

#### Carrum Downs Bus:

Cost per annum per student \$ 620

Places on the bus are subject to transport regulations. Should demand exceed bus capacity preference will be given to junior students and a waiting list will be created.

As places are limited, casual use of the bus is not available.

#### Instrumental Music Lessons:

Individual lessons per semester (per 16 lessons) \$ 544 or (per 8 lessons) \$ 272

Shared lessons per semester (per 16 lessons) \$ 320 or (per 8 lessons) \$ 160

#### VET Course Fees

VET Courses provide students with a range of alternate learning pathways. These courses are conducted by external course providers and fees for these courses are in addition to those of John Paul College.

The funding provided to John Paul College for VET courses is subject to change each year, and every effort is made to keep VET fees as low as possible. Transportation, protective clothing, excursion and material costs are payable in addition to the John Paul College VET fee. Charges for these items will be made to parent's fee accounts once the information has been provided to the College. Parents please note VET course providers will invoice the College for their full school year fee. Should your child withdraw from the course or leave the school after the organisation's cut off date, the full year's fees will remain payable by you. VET courses available under the above fee basis are subject to approval by John Paul College. The College website has details of John Paul College VET fees.
